

HOW TO WAIVE FERPA RIGHTS




STEP 1 | FE

- Create a Common App Account
- Add Colleges
- Locate the "Recommenders and FERPA" tab
- Complete the FERPA Release Authorization
- Check the box under the RELEASE AUTHORIZATION section that you have read and understand the waiver
- Fill out the Student's Demo Graphics(ONLY and then click the Colleges tab again)
- Locate the "Recommenders and FERPA tab again

FERPA

- Check: I WAIVE MY RIGHT TO REVIEW ALL RECOMMENDATIONS
- Check: Bottom Square Box that your WAIVER SELECTION PERTAINS TO ALL COLLEGES
- Type in your name in the SIGNATURE box and select the date
- Once you complete all of the above, you will be brought back to the main MY COLLEGES page and you will see the RECOMMENDERS AND FERPA section has a green check
- Save and Close





STEP 2
