

## **Dual Enrollment Cheat Sheet**

<u>Note</u>: If you are *currently* taking dual enrollment courses this semester, **skip to step 3**, unless you are changing schools (colleges). Steps 1-3 can be done in any order and/or simultaneously.

\*Step 1: <u>College Application</u> - Apply to the college of your choice. <u>Here</u> is a list of participating colleges.

- The most common schools are:
  - o Georgia Piedmont Technical College
  - GSU Perimeter: 3.0 & certain SAT, ACT, or PSAT score. 3.4 <, test score not required.</li>
  - GSU Downtown: 3.0 & certain SAT, ACT, or PSAT score. 3.4 <, test score not required.</li>
- Send your transcript to the college through:
- GA Futures (FREE)
  - Create an account.
  - Go to "My High School Transcript"

**Step 3: Choose Classes** - Find the course(s) you would like to take and **fill out the course** request form for <u>SUMMER 2025</u> or <u>FALL 2025</u> so that they can be approved for payment.

- Approved Course List
  - Courses without prerequisites that satisfy graduation requirements
    - Senior English: ENGL 1101
    - Economics: ECON 1101 ONLY
    - Fourth Math: MATH 1401, MATH 1101, MATH 1111, MATH 1112, MATH 1113, MATH 2211, MATH 2420
    - Fourth Science: Any Dual Enrollment Science class, ALHS 1011

**Step 4: Register for Classes (this step may take place after the deadline)** - Once you've been admitted into the college, register for the course(s) **with the college**. Instructions for registration will be provided by the college. *Filling out the course request form does not register you for the classes, it just approves the classes for payment*. If you make **ANY** changes to your requested course list, **let your counselor know or fill out another form.** 

**DeKalb County's Deadlines:** 

Fall & Summer: March 15<sup>th</sup> Spring: October 15<sup>th</sup>

<sup>\*</sup> Step 2: Pay For Classes - Fill out the <u>Funding Application</u> on <u>GA Futures</u> for **25-26 school year**.
