

DHHS IB Scheduling and Course Selection Information

In order to begin the IB Program in the 11th grade, by the end of 10th grade year:

- Students must have at least a 3.2 gpa
- Students must have up to Advanced Algebra (Algebra II) completed
- Students must have up to the 3rd level of the same world language completed i.e. Spanish I, Spanish II, & Spanish III
- Students must have Biology and Chemistry completed
- Students are **HIGHLY** encouraged to complete Economics
