HOW TO START YOUR CREDIT RECOVERY COURSE

1. Log into **www.gacreditrecovery.org**
2. Click on “My CR Classes.”
3. You’ll get a pop up. Click continue.
4. It will ask for an email address and password. The email will be [“username”@gavirtualschool.org](mailto:username@gavirtualschool.org) The password will be the **exact** same password used when you first logged in. Click “Sign in”
5. After logging in, allow 24 hours for your course to appear on your Dashboard.
6. Your course will be on your Dashboard.
7. Click on your course.
8. You will see all of your assignments. You can only access assignments that are not grayed out.
9. Review the course welcome and course overview. You are now ready to take the pretest for unit one.
10. Click on the pretest link.
11. You must view the entire unit before the post-test link will be available. If you are not able to move forward on an assignment, check your previous assignment's score. If it is below passing, you must re-do it.
12. You must score at least 70% on the post-test to move on to your next pre-test.
13. ELA classes have required essays that can be completed at any time. They are located at the bottom of the page.

Notes:

1. You have only one attempt on the final exam.
2. EOC courses will not have a final exam. You will take the EOC which will count for 20% of your grade.
3. English courses have an essay requirement. These essays count as a post-test grade. You only have 1 attempt at each essay. It must be completed 2 weeks prior to the course end date to allow time for grading.
