**Honors diploma requires 3 world language credits and a 3.5 weighted GPA*

Promotion Requirements

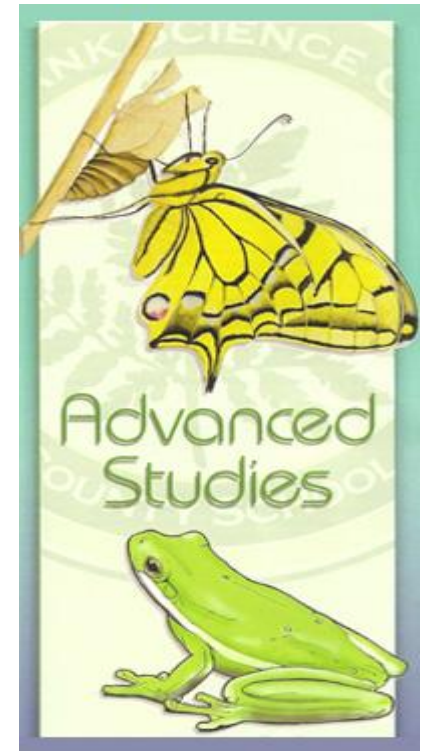
Promotion to 10th grade -6 credits/3 core
